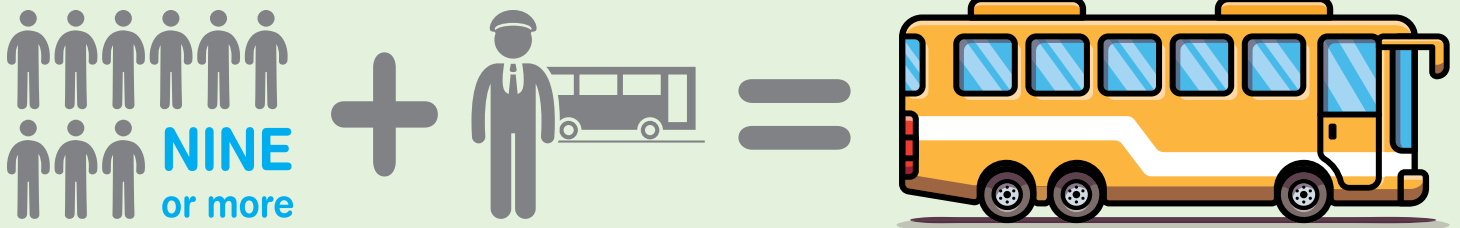


Motor Carriers

Motor Carriers are classified to include commercial bus companies, school bus operations, and van pools with a capacity of 9 or more passengers, excluding the driver.



Motor Carrier License Requirements:

1. Insurance



Insurance requirements are as follows:

- **vehicles 20 passengers and under**
\$2,000,000 Third Party Liability (inclusive limits) and \$2,000,000 passenger liability and property damage (inclusive limits)
- **vehicles 21 passengers or over**
\$2,000,000 third party liability (inclusive limits) and \$3,000,000 passenger liability and property damage (inclusive limits)

2. Vehicle Inspection



Vehicle Inspection required:

- A semi-annual inspection by a Motor Carrier Division inspector (no fee)

The owner is responsible to

- a) supply a place for the Inspector to inspect the vehicle(s), and
- b) supply a person other than the Inspector to drive the vehicle during the road and brake test portion of the inspection.

3. Vehicle Plating



- The annual plating fee is \$515.30 per vehicle.
- An additional \$257.65 is required for each extra-provincial plate.
- If the applicant is applying for an extra-provincial plate only, the fee is \$515.30 per plate.

NOTE: It is recommended that new applicants do not invest in vehicles until they have been granted an operating authority by the Board.
